

Waterford Union High School Academic Hall of Fame

The purpose of the Waterford Hall of Fame is to recognize those individuals who have brought distinction, honor and excellence to Waterford Union High School through their unselfish efforts to make the world a better place through their Professional, Entertainment, Military, Community Service, and Business contributions. Any alumnus, long-serving faculty member, or community supporter may be nominated to the Hall of Fame. By honoring these positive role models, we hope to inspire current students to distinguish themselves through their achievements.

Nomination Procedures

1. **Any non-voting member of the public, student body, faculty and staff, or administration may make nominations for membership to the Waterford Union High School Hall of Fame.** All nominations may be submitted via electronic nomination form or may be dropped off at the Waterford Union High School District Office, 507 West Main Street, Waterford, WI 53185. Incomplete forms will not be considered. Nomination forms are available on the District's webpage at the high school's website at www.waterforduhs.k12.wi.us. All nominations must be submitted to the District office by February 15 of each year in order to be considered.
 - A. Nomination forms will request the following information: name, graduation date/date of service, list of recognition/awards/accomplishments, rationale (a narrative), and contact information for both the applicant and nominee.
 - B. All nominations will receive an automated acknowledgement thanking them for their nomination, indicating that nominees will stay eligible for five years and encouraging applicants to provide additional information for consideration if it comes available in the future.
2. **Publicity for nominations** will be disseminated through the District's newsletter, press releases, social media, and publication at public locations, including the Waterford Public Library, the Village Hall, Waterford Senior Living, and area churches. Information will also be presented at high school events, such as homecoming, concerts, and games.
3. **Nominations must satisfy the following qualifications:**
 - A. **Student nominees** must have graduated from Waterford Union High School. Nominees are not eligible until ten (10) years after their graduation date from WUHS.
 - B. **Staff nominees** must have worked for the District at least ten (10) years. Staff members must be five (5) years removed from service at WUHS to qualify for the Hall of Fame.
 - C. **Honorary nominees** may be someone who does not meet the above criteria, including a community member, staff member, or volunteer, who has had a long-standing and significant impact on the school by providing excellent leadership or innovative ideas.
 - D. **Posthumous nominees** may be made, in which case a representative of the family -- if available -- will receive the award on the recipient's behalf.
