General Schedule Description:

This schedule runs in a structured format with direct instruction. Teachers will be available for communication/direct instruction during designated class hours that mirror a normal schedule. Students and teachers "attend" classes on an abbreviated bell schedule. **Attendance** will be taken by teachers during each class period through various means, no attendance will be recorded during study halls. If students are going to be **absent**, parents need to communicate the information to attendance 534-3150 or 844-408-1679. Mini-breaks are built in between classes with a mid-schedule break for re-organizing or re-grouping. Teachers establish times of availability during the virtual learning day. **Assignments** will be posted by teachers no later than 9:20 A.M. the morning of a lesson. Please work with your teachers for clarification of their individual expectations.

Learning Plan: The schedule was established to assist with the instructional delivery of virtual learning. Despite virtual instruction evolving and becoming more mainstream over the past decade, the district anticipates challenges for teachers and students not familiar with a virtual environment. Our desired state is to maintain uninterrupted classroom instruction and student learning during this state of emergency.

Students are accountable for attending virtual learning days just as they are during a face-to-face learning day. Students are expected to follow general learning expectations: **Be Prepared, Be Respectful, Be Responsive**

Tips for Successful Learning:

- Communicate with a school administrator if you do not have access to the internet, a phone with a data plan, or other means to log into school accounts remotely. The school phone number is **262-534-3189**.
- Access slides/notes and assignments that accompany the lesson
- Submit assignments and assessments through Google Classroom, Schoology, or other tools in a timely manner.
- Communicate with teachers through alternate means such as email, telephone, Google Voice, Zoom, Google Meet, Google Chat, or by other appropriate means.
- Make sure you understand the directions and expectations for assignments or projects.
- Demonstrate integrity when completing assignments and assessments.
- Ask teachers questions or share concerns.
- Students with IEP's or 504's should communicate with case managers or school counselors.
- Manage your time wisely.
- Tech support will be available starting Wednesday. Check your school Gmail for additional information at that time.

Background:

Governor Tony Evers mandates the closure of all public and private K-12 schools in Wisconsin on March 13, 2020. As a result of this action, Waterford Union High School will ensure that students receive learning that meets and/or exceeds the [DPI requirements for virtual learning days](#). The following information established guidelines and expectations for remote, virtual learning when extended school closures occur.

Timeline:

Per the Governor's office, *all public and private **schools will close beginning at 5pm on Wednesday, March 18**. The **anticipated reopening date of schools is April 6, 2020**, but this will be re-evaluated as updated information becomes available. This means students cannot enter the building for curricular or extracurricular activities. If students need to pick up learning packets from teachers or technology help, please work with the teacher or support and administration.*

Per the WIAA, *there will be **no WIAA athletics** at any member school from Wednesday, March 18, 2020, to Monday, April 6, 2020. This includes all participation including, but not limited to training, practices, scrimmages, and contests. Schools and/or coaches may not bring students together during this time period for extracurricular or athletic purposes such as practices or other instructional/organizational purposes. Schools and/or coaches may not be involved with students during their time period to provide instruction for practice purposes. Coaches may provide individual workouts virtually, but shall not encourage or organize their team assembling to practice.*
